- 1 SCC wishes to honour the consensus agreement made earlier this spring by all partners, and not to ask for a continuance, and as follows, finalize the project virtually.
- 2 I think that all outputs and objectives of the project have been pursued according to the initial plan.
 - The fundamental change was just to eliminate the direct meetings (both learning and management meetings).
 - A discussion and a request for extension was initiated by ASIE a year ago but was not approved by coordinating organisation at the time and we were encouraged to work as planned and meet online, regularly. We consider that since we managed to adapt for this style of approach and the project followed so far the initial objectives and timeline, an extension at this time would not be useful/appropriate.
- We believe that it is possible to finish planned project activities on time and there is no need for project extension. Now it is better to focus on finishing activities than filling extra applications or forms that need attention. And even if the project is extended there is no guaranty that the physical meetings will be possible because of the pandemic.

- The Management Board of the Parasol Foundation, after several meetings with people involved in the implementation of the Green Way project, agreed that it is not against to the extension of the project. It was decided that by extending its implementation it will be possible to meet partners, which will have a positive impact on the implementation of the entire project. The only reason to extension of the project is COVID 19.
- We are available to an extension, in case partners are experiencing severe problems (cant't maintain project schedule, unable to accomplish all required tasks, etc).
